

PARENTS' ADVISORY COUNCILS

Background

The School Act provides for parents of students at a school to organize a parents' advisory council for that school.

The District supports the organization of a school parents' advisory council with a resolution authorizing its establishment and by providing assistance with the development of a constitution.

Procedures

1. The decision to organize a parents' advisory council (PAC) will be school-based.
2. Only one PAC is permitted in a school.
3. The Secretary-Treasurer will make available a draft constitution incorporating a set of operating bylaws to any school desiring to organize a PAC.
4. The Board will name a liaison trustee for each school. The school's liaison trustee facilitates communication between the Board and each school's PAC.
