

BOARD/AUTHORITY AUTHORIZED COURSES

Background

The District supports the development of courses that are not provided through Ministry curriculum offerings.

The Superintendent is responsible for establishing the process for the approval of locally developed courses.

Procedures

1. All proposed courses will be submitted in draft to the Superintendent, or a committee which is struck for the purpose of reviewing such courses (e.g. Curriculum Development Advisory Committee).
2. The Superintendent will review such drafts prior to presentation to the Board for its approval.
3. Courses approved for implementation must be approved by April 1 of the year preceding proposed implementation.
