

STUDENT VANDALISM

Background

Any student who willfully or irresponsibly damages or destroys school property is to be financially responsible for such damage.

The District is insured by the School Protection Program, an agency of the provincial government, and therefore must act consistently with the requirements of the insuring agency.

Procedures

1. Where school property is damaged accidentally by students the Principal concerned shall assess the damage and determine the amount, if any, recoverable from parents or students.
2. In cases of intentional malicious damage or removal of school property the students responsible, if proven, may be prosecuted for recovery of costs if restitution is not made voluntarily.
3. Where proven, or admitted to, damage caused by students, where voluntary payment of costs is not forthcoming, may be recovered by legal action at the discretion of the Secretary-Treasurer.
